Scholarship Entry Rules

Only one entry per student will be accepted.

Candidate must be a graduating senior.

Candidate should be college bound by fall 2022.

Candidates should create an original written entry specifically for this scholarship award.

Submission Process

- Complete the scholarship application form; staple to the front of the entry.
- Entries must focus on any theme related to honor, courage, and commitment. May be descriptive and/or issue oriented and may be of any genre.
- Entries will consist of one written work, which may be as brief as a haiku or as long as six pages of poetry or prose, which can include any form such as non-fiction, fiction, poetry, personal opinion, journalism, or any other that suits the author's purpose.
- Entries should be double-spaced, 12 point Times New Roman font. (Larger font and/or bold or italicized print may be used in titles, headings, or sparingly as a stylistic tool in the work.) Number all pages and staple.
- Entries must include a statement of originality signed by the student, parent/legal guardian, and a sponsor (teacher, mentor, counselor). The statement of originality may include any information the student chooses; however, the student must include, in student's own handwriting, the following statement: The enclosed writing sample is my original work.
- Submit two copies of the work; each copy should include the scholarship form and the originality statement.

Though it should be submitted in conjunction with LAD Fair entries, this scholarship is not part of the LAD Fair writing competition; an applicant should not use a LAD Fair entry sheet. Use the 2022 SWMO Marine Corps League Detachment 993 Scholarship Application Form.
